

The International School on AstroParticle Physics (ISAPP) is a network of more than 30 research institutions and doctoral schools from France, Germany, Israel, Italy, the Netherlands, Norway, Russia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

ISAPP's mission is to promote exchanges between doctoral schools, and to develop a joint education through the organization of PhD summer schools and summer institutes on astroparticle physics (usually 2-3 per year, 10 days long each).

The schools' subjects concentrate on the main topics of astroparticle physics:

Neutrino physics and astrophysics, dark matter, dark energy, cosmic microwave background radiation, cosmology and the early universe, cosmic rays, gamma rays, gravitational waves and multi-messenger astronomy.

Each ISAPP school is conceived as an up-to-date didactic course of lectures at the level of a doctoral school and its structure perfectly fits with a PhD course.
